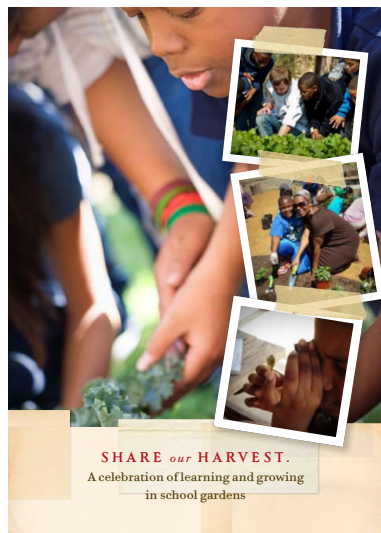

“REAL SCHOOL GARDENS”

Children at four high-poverty Fort Worth elementary schools are learning more than math and science in their school gardens. Sponsored by the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation, and with the support of REAL School Gardens and GRACE restaurant, students at the participating schools are getting a hands-on lesson in healthy eating—and learning about future career opportunities. On Monday, Wednesday and Friday of this week, GRACE restaurant co-owners Adam and Caroline Jones and GRACE Executive Chef Blaine Staniford are paying visits to all four of the participating schools where students have spent the past two months growing produce for a special dinner at the restaurant. A group of students, parents, and teachers from each of the schools will enjoy the fruits of their labors at GRACE restaurant on Friday, November 9. Diners attending a ticketed wine dinner following the children's meal will have the opportunity to meet the young growers and learn about how outdoor learning is growing academic achievement in North Texas schools. The four participating Fort Worth schools this year are D. McRae Elementary, I.M. Terrell Elementary, Meadowbrook Elementary, and T.A. Sims Elementary.
